Hair, makeup, attire, tickets, and rides to prom cost families an average of more than \$1600 according to stylists, event planners, and surveys.

Visa researchers learned that families making under \$25,000 will spend a total of \$1,393 for the prom, while families who make over \$50,000 will spend an average of \$799. When asking why pay the expense, families respond with, "it's worth it to make my young person feel special and a part of something they will never forget."
